Report on the Survey Conducted Among the Students of Government Holkar (Model Autonomous) Science College, Indore to Know the Relevance of Their Course to the local, regional, national, and global needs and cross-cutting issues.

Introduction:

The survey was conducted among the students of Holkar Science College to determine the relevance of their courses to the local, regional, national, and global needs and cross-cutting issues. The aim of the survey was to gauge the students' perceptions of the courses they are taking and identify areas for utonomous) Science improvement.

Results:

The survey results indicate that the courses have moderate relevance to the local, national, regional, and global developmental needs. The average response for the question "To what extent do the courses you are reading have relevance to the local developmental needs?" was 3.52, and for the national developmental needs, it was 3.67. For the regional developmental needs, the average response was 3.55, and for the global developmental needs, it was 3.65.

Regarding cross-cutting issues, the survey found that the courses moderately promote social justice, equity, and inclusivity, with an average response of 3.49. The courses also moderately promote environmental sustainability and conservation, with an average response of 3.61. The courses moderately promote human values such as empathy, compassion, and respect for diversity, with an average response of 3.58. The courses also moderately promote gender equality and empowerment, with an average response of 3.61. Finally, the courses moderately raise awareness of ethical considerations in decision-making related to business and social issues, with an average response of 3.54.

Conclusion:

In conclusion, the survey conducted among the students of Holkar Science College suggests that the courses have moderate relevance to the local, national, regional, and global developmental needs. The courses also moderately promote
