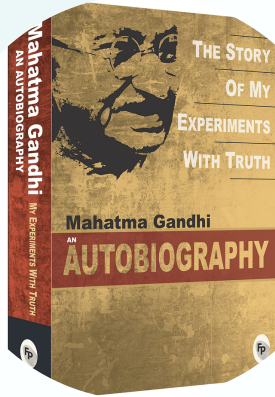

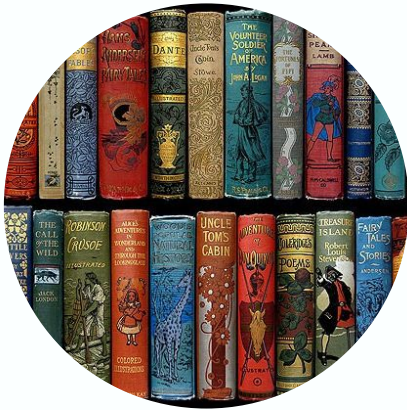

REPORT OF LIBRARY-STUDENT ORIENTATION PROGRAMME
(24.05.2022 to 26.05.2022)

Introduction:

Holkar Science College is well known for its rich collection of books in its library. But with the advent of technological tools, Covid-19 pandemic, it becomes essential for us to motivate students to use the library physically. To apprise the students regarding various physical facilities in the library along with the e-facilities, a three-day Library Orientation Programme and book fair on three different themes were organized for students with a belief that organizing a book fair in a library can be a great way to encourage reading, promote literacy, and raise student foot fall for the library.

Outcomes:

Arranging a book fair had several positive outcomes, including:

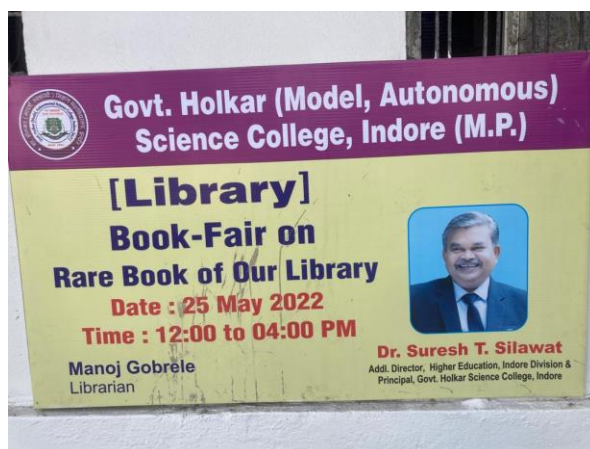

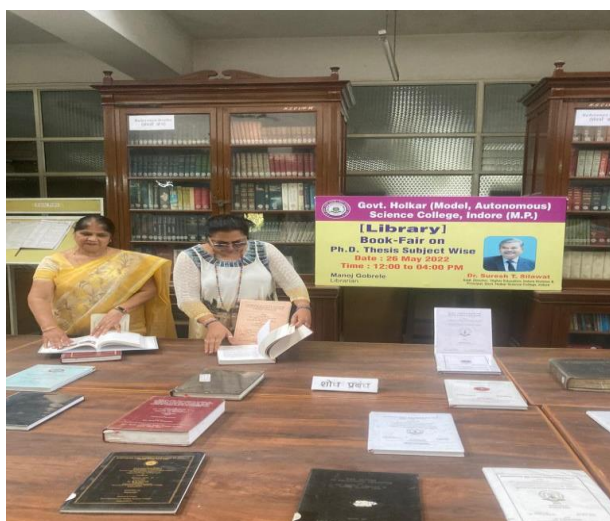
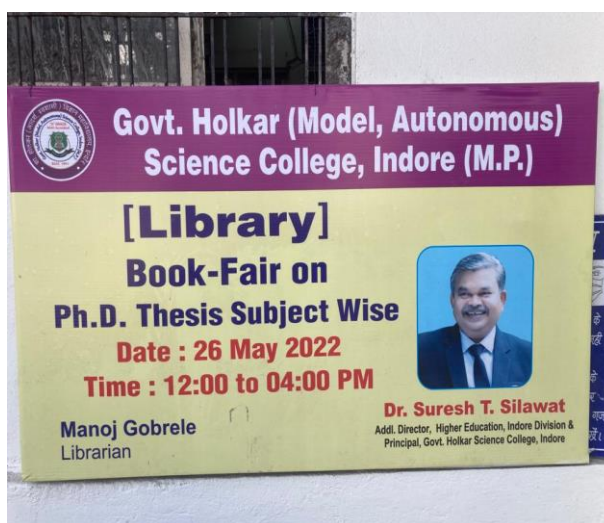

Day-2: Book-Exhibition on available Ph.D. Thesis in the Library

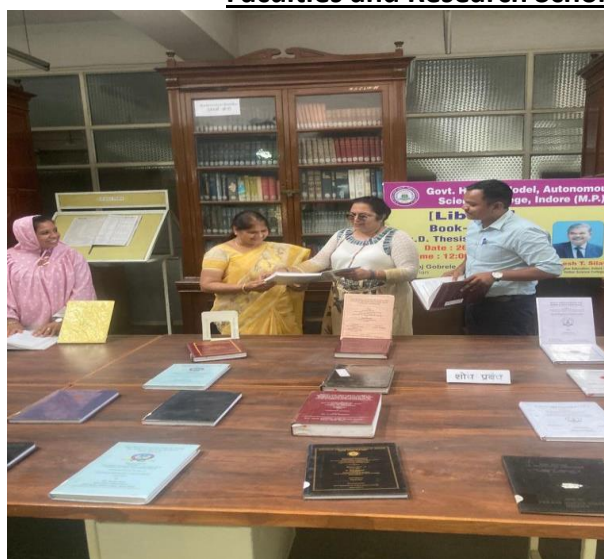
(26.05.2022)
